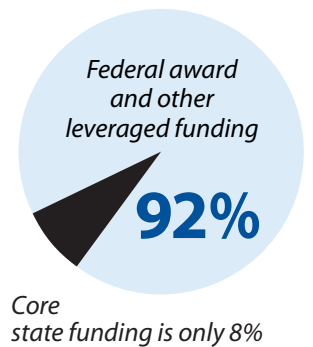

NYSG is a federal/state matching funds program

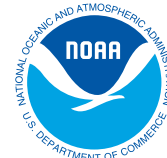

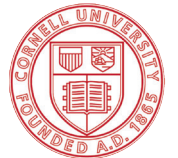
