




MOUTH SHAPES




SUPERIOR MOUTH

- Eats food above it
- May eat at the water's surface



TERMINAL MOUTH • Eats food in front of it




- Eats food below it
- May eat off of the bottom

BODY SHAPES




OVATE BODY

- Slow swimmer
- Difficult for predators to swallow



FUSIFORM BODY High speed swimmers



ELONGATE


• Hides in rocks and weeds

CAUDAL / TAIL FIN SHAPES



HETEROCERCAL TAIL

- Fast swimmer
- Constantly moving



Fast swimmer




· Long distance swimmer




POINTED TAIL
