
## Internal/External Anatomy of a Fish

- 1. List three body systems that both humans and fish have.

Gills	Protects fish from parasites and bacteria in the water
Lateral Line	Filters toxins from a fish's blood stream and creates waste
Slime Layer	Filled with gases; helps the fish move up and down in the water column.
Swim Bladder	Helps with digestion processes
Kidneys	Allows the fish to hear and feel vibrations in the water
Pyloric Cacae	Secretes bile to aid in digestion
Liver	Allows fish to breath underwater
