
Kayak Club to Host Larissa Graham Of the Long Island Sound Study

In 1985, the Long Island Sound Study was formed as a partnership and cooperative effort involving researchers, regulators, user groups, environmentalists and other concerned organizations and individuals. Larissa Graham, outreach coordinator of the Long Island Sound Study, will focus on the problems facing the Sound and the status of progress when she appears as the guest speaker at the next meeting of the North Shore Kayak Club. It is scheduled for Thursday, Oct. 20 at 7:30 p.m., at the Community Chest Building ground floor conference room, 382 Main Street in Port Washington. The meeting is open to all and parking is available directly across the street at the town dock.

With 20 million people living within a 50 mile radius of Long Island Sound, maintaining a healthy ecosystem, while balancing human uses, presents a daunting challenge. The problems facing Long Island Sound are quite significant. Oxygen levels in some areas of the Sound have dropped to levels that have caused fish to die; and, the legacy of pollution discharged into the Sound has led to advisories on how much fish can be consumed.
