Marine and Coastal District License Plate

The New York State Marine and Coastal District License Plate was released to establish a small grants program, which is administered by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation in partnership with New York Sea Grant. Six awards were supported in the first cycle to conduct a range of projects to educate anglers about marine resources.



The New York State Marine and Coastal District License Plate supports not-for-profit organizations that apply to the Marine and coastal district of New York conservation, education, and research small grants program, established under NYS Environmental Conservation Law Article 13, Title 5 Section 13-0501. This fund is used to "promote sport fishing, increase participation in recreational angling, increase public awareness and appreciation of aquatic natural resources, encourage conservation of fisheries resources, or promote research relating to the marine and coastal district of New York". A three-member Board appointed by the governor, temporary president of the senate, and speaker of the assembly, oversees this fund, and this grant program is presently being administered through New York Sea Grant.
